### Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

From January 18<sup>th</sup> through to January 25<sup>th</sup> we celebrate the week of prayer for Christian Unity. Let us take this opportunity to remember our brothers and sisters who belong to other Churches: that the Holy Spirit may lead us into the fullness of truth.

## Early Lent

A reminder that we are very close to the beginning of Lent, which is early for 2024. **Ash Wednesday will be February 14<sup>th</sup>**. There will be three masses that day: 9 am, 4 pm and 7 pm. Please remember to start bringing in your old palms to the Church so that they may be burned on Shrove Tuesday.
