#### Fasting and Abstinence during Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting and abstinence from meat. All Fridays are days of Abstinence. Fasting means that the amount of food we eat is considerably reduced. Abstinence means that give up eating meat. Those over 18 are bound by the law of fasting until the beginning of their 60<sup>th</sup> year, while all who are over 14 are bound by the law of abstinence.
