Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

From time immemorial, people have asked whether there really is life after death and, if so, what kind of life it would be. Some have suggested that life simply ends in nothingness. For them, the world is just a war-torn and violent waiting room where death has the last word. We Christians, on the other hand, today shout "Alleluia" because Jesus Christ has been raised from the ! dead. His Resurrection is neither a myth nor a dream. It wasn't a vision. Nor is Lit a fairy tale. It is a singular and unrepeatable event in the history of the cosi mos. At Easter we celebrate that He conquered sin and death, opening us to a future of hope. If you sincerely seek the Lord, rest assured that you will find Him. Indeed, He will come to find you, to meet you. Calling you by name, He will take you into the intimacy of His !love and ask you, in return, to share your experience with others. ! With my blessing, prayers and warmest best wishes for a joyous celebration of · Easter.
